

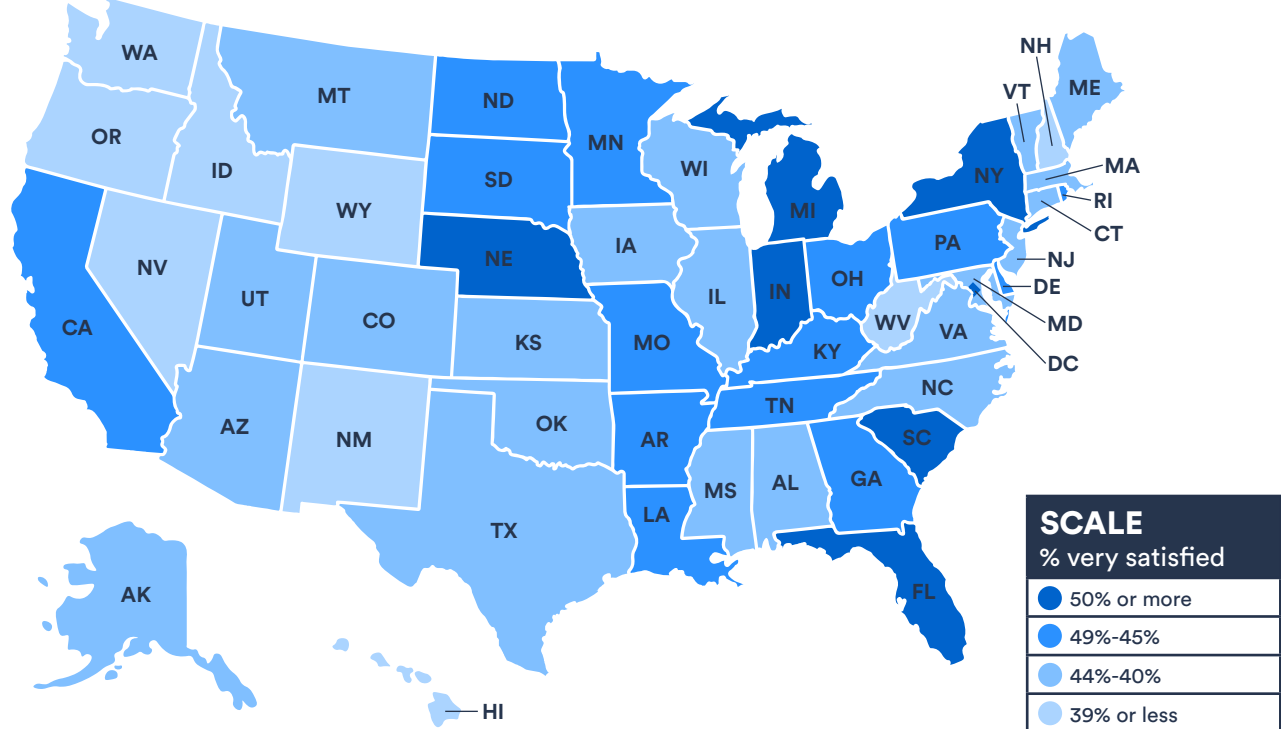

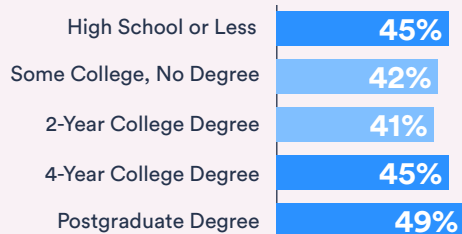

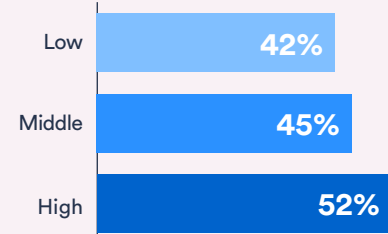

School Satisfaction by Parent’s Education



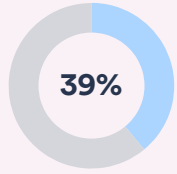
School Satisfaction by Household Income



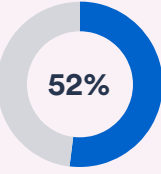

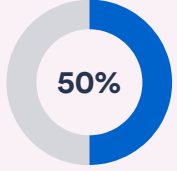

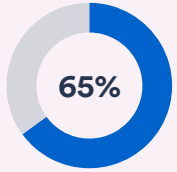

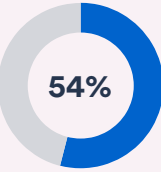

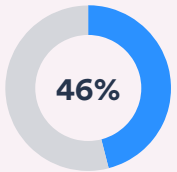

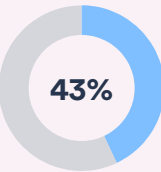

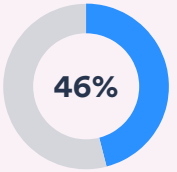

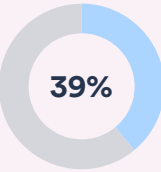

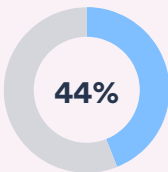

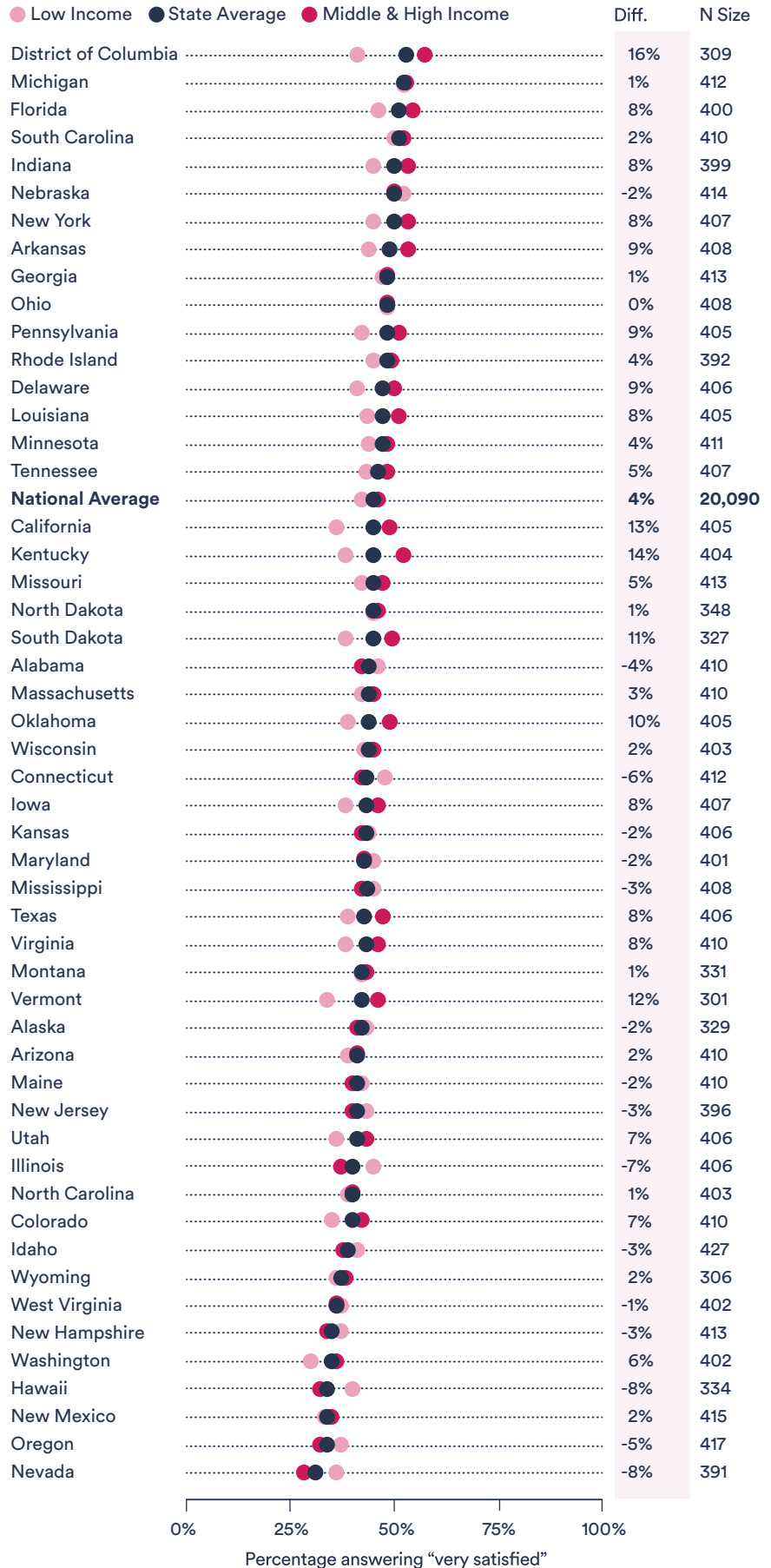

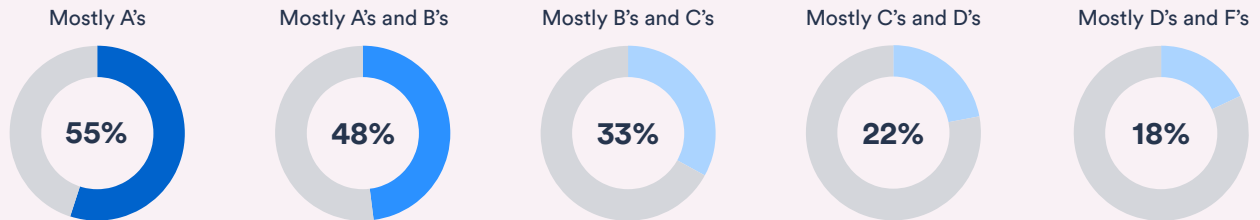

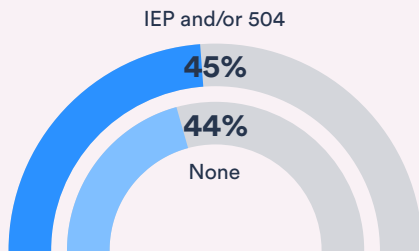

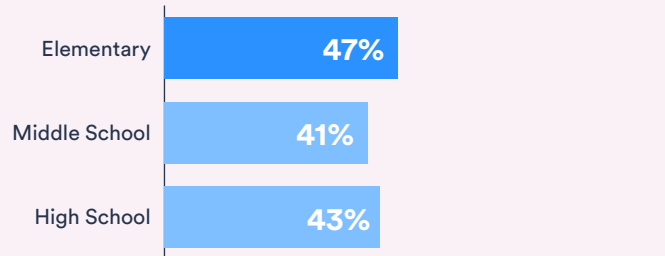
School Satisfaction by Child’s Grades



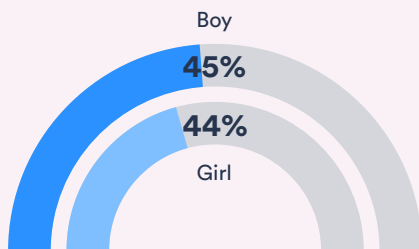
School Satisfaction by Special Education



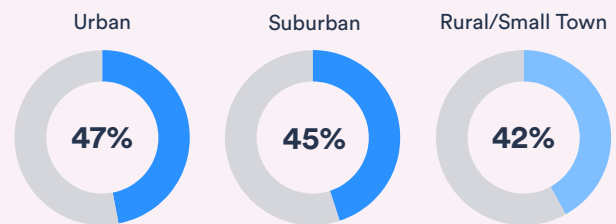
School Satisfaction by Child’s Grade Level



School Satisfaction by Child’s Gender



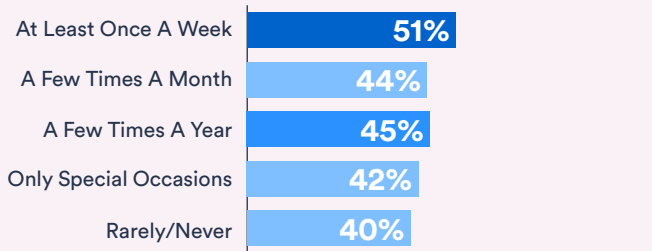
School Satisfaction by Geographic Area



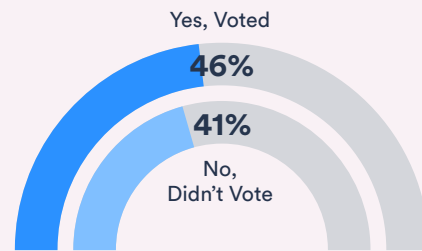

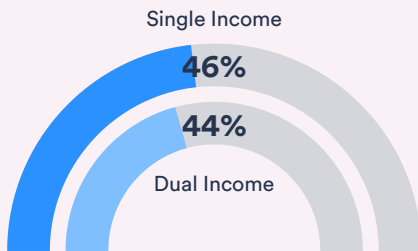
School Satisfaction by Religious Attendance



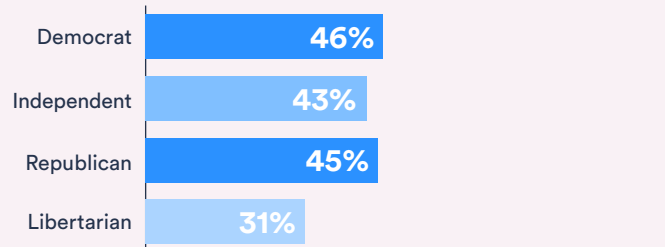
School Satisfaction by Voted in Last Presidential Election



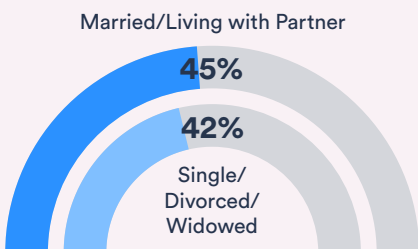
School Satisfaction by Single/Dual Income Household
